

The Circuitry of the Body

If we want to know how the universe operates, it is sometimes advisable to look at our bodies to find out how it really functions. All the wonders of the world are also in our bodies. What is special is that we ourselves are in this body and, if we learn to direct our attention toward the processes in our bodies, we can observe its way of functioning from inside. It is easy to understand the simile of the body. If we were to keep on enlarging the body we would finally have a system, which like the universe almost only consists of “nothing”. The seemingly solid pieces of matter, such as bones, muscles, etc. would dissolve into a galactic fog with more or less dense energy fields. In between there would be nothing. It seems, then, that matter consists of “nothingness” in motion, i.e. of energy motions. Our body is like the body of an energetic vibratory system, in which all individual vibrations are in resonance with the whole.

There is something very mysterious about our bodies. If, for example, my little toe itches, then how do I know the place that is itching, and where does my ability to scratch the right place, even with my eyes closed, come from? Here, finally, we can no longer get around holographic thinking. It is no longer physiological or mechanical models, but holographic ones that provide the necessary answers. It is no longer the familiar world of linear cause and effect connections, but the new world of endless intertwined loops, circles and holographic projections that we need to enter in order to understand the living world. Here the real “course in miracles” occurs, in which every step we take as we discover our bodies can lead us to a new universal insight.

Let us go back to the itching toe. Somewhere in the body of the universe something is itching and my holographic positioning system recognizes where: it is the small toe of the left foot. The little toe cries out into the universe: please scratch! That is its prayer. Now something incredible happens, something that one needs to contemplate for a long time in order to understand and to believe that it is possible. The entire universe reacts to the prayer; the entire body bends over in order to scratch the toe. Is it not incredible what power such a small part has over the whole and how this whole puts its entire power and skills in the service of this tiny part? The universe bends over and – thanks to permanent feedback in the circuit between central control, the finger, and the toe - the finger finds the right place. All particles, all energy vortices and galaxies of the body, participate in fulfilling the prayer that the little toe cried out. Everything is put into motion to fulfill the prayer, and yet it all remains as well coordinated as it was before. We must let our mind dwell on this for a long time in order to get a sense of what is happening here. It is the most perfect demonstration of the art that is inherent in a holographically constructed world. At the same time it is the perfect demonstration of a prayer being heard.

In principle, it makes no difference if the prayer is sent as a neuro-physiological impulse from my little toe to my brain or if I consciously send a prayer to central control, for I, too, like the little toe, am an organ of the whole. Just as the universe of my body hears and fulfills the prayer of my body, my prayer is also heard and fulfilled by the universe of overall Creation. I regard this simile as being correct and precise. It shows the immediacy with which permanent communication and feedback occurs between a part and the whole. It especially shows us that a correctly spoken prayer **cannot** remain unfulfilled in an intact overall organism, provided the overall organism does not decide to injure itself. The little toe’s prayer of “please scratch” cannot but be fulfilled unless there happens to be an important reason to postpone scratching, because other things have to be done first. We must allow the soul of the world this time, for it may say: wait a little while, for certain other things must first occur. If someone, for example, prays that the love with a desired partner may blossom again, then it is possible that the soul of the world, in the form of his/her inner voice clearly states that there is something that must be dealt with first. There may, for example, be a certain swindle or lack

of integrity that must first be eliminated in order for trust to be able to grow. For this we do not need to make our way through any putrid swamps of the soul or fall into profound broodings, for the helping voice is often very clear and simple. One cannot doubt the existence of the inner voice. The broodings usually do not stem from any deep problem of existence having to do with the theory of insights, but from the fog of our old habits and ego games.

The fulfillment of prayers is not a question of our beliefs, it is a spiritual natural law. We are at the beginning of the development of a spiritual science, and the further we go, the more the basic knowledge of humanity comes up to meet us. During the developmental phase that lies ahead we cannot avoid discovering and using the laws of the spiritual world, just like the laws of a mechanical world have been discovered and used. For this, however, we need an inner ability that is clearly different from those that we have used before. We need the ability and the inner willingness to connect in everyday life with the vibrations of life and love. We need the ability to contact and communicate with the world. If we are in the state of separation, we cannot use the spiritual laws in a meaningful way. Prayers only function in a state of connection. The divine world needs this connection in order to provide us with its wisdom and its power, just as the body needs the little toe.
